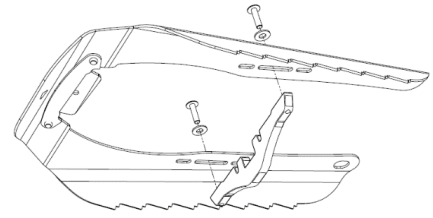




TECHNICAL NOTICE SnowPlak® Approach



Concept:

SnowPlak Approach is a removable snowshoe plate system that can be fitted to a mountaineering boot equipped with semi-automatic ice crampons, without having to remove the crampon from the boot.

A SnowPlak Approach is composed of:

- U-shaped aluminium plate with side knives.
- Adjustable aluminium bar for shoe support and crampon centering
- Straps with aluminium quick-release buckles with hooks
- M5 screws and washers

Weight, dimensions: 750g / pair, 23x37x5cm

Material: anodised aluminium

Use:

The SnowPlak Approach is designed to make walking on loose snow easier, while keeping the crampons at feet. They should not be used without crampons.

The two pieces of equipment together form a snowshoe that facilitates the approach and the hike, in the context of the usual use of a snowshoe.

Safety:

The SnowPlak should be used on soft snow and removed on hard snow and ice. We recommend that the SnowPlak Approach be used only on soft snow and in terrain configurations where crampon only mode is not essential for safety. The crampons should only be used in their nominal range of use as recommended by the manufacturer in his instructions.
